**Nonstock Corporations
Articles of Dissolution**

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

Form 110 may be used to file articles of dissolution for a nonstock corporation ("corporation"). A corporation is not required to use this form to file its articles of dissolution; however, if a corporation doesn't want to use this form, it will need to ensure that it provides the Department of Financial Institutions ("department") with all of the information that is required by [s. 181.1403 Wis. Stats.](#) at the time it files. Please note that this form contains only the minimal information required by [s. 181.1403 Wis. Stats.](#), and may not meet every corporation's needs. Department staff cannot provide legal advice regarding this matter.

Upon receipt of this document, the department shall stamp or otherwise endorse the date of receipt on the original. The department may return an acknowledgement copy as confirmation of the date of receipt.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Enter the name of the corporation.
2. Enter the date the dissolution was authorized.
3. Was the dissolution approved by a sufficient vote of the board? Please check yes or no.
4. Identify the statutory grounds for dissolution under [s. 181 Wis. Stats.](#) by checking one of the boxes.

APPROVAL OF DISSOLUTION BY MEMBERS IS NOT REQUIRED ([181.1403\(1\)\(d\) Wis. Stats.](#)): If approval of members was not required, then the dissolution was approved by a sufficient vote of either the Incorporators or Board of Directors. Please check the appropriate box.

APPROVAL OF DISSOLUTION BY MEMBERS IS REQUIRED ([181.1403\(1\)\(e\) Wis. Stats.](#)): If approval of members is required, then the dissolution was approved by a sufficient vote of the members of each class entitled to vote on dissolution. Please check the appropriate box.

APPROVAL OF DISSOLUTION BY 3RD PERSON ([181.1403\(1\)\(f\) Wis. Stats.](#)): If approval of dissolution by a person other than the members, the board or the incorporators is required under [s.181.1401 \(1\)\(b\) Wis. Stats.](#) Check the appropriate box.

If the corporation is to retain the exclusive use of its name for less than 120 days after the effective date of its articles of dissolution, as provided in [s. 181.1405 \(3\)](#), a statement specifying the shorter period is requested. If left blank the corporation will retain the name for 120 days.

5. Enter the name of the drafter of the articles of dissolution. If the articles of dissolution are executed in Wisconsin, [s. 182.01\(3\) Wis. Stats.](#) provides that they shall not be filed unless the name of the drafter (either an individual or a governmental agency) is printed in a legible manner. If the articles of dissolution were not executed in Wisconsin, enter the remark "Not Executed in Wisconsin".

6. Enter the name of the individual who executed this document. A person authorized by the entity may execute a document described in Ch. 181.

OPTIONAL INFORMATION:

7. *Delayed Effective Date, If applicable:*

Subject to the conditions set forth in [s. 181.00209, Wis. Stats.](#), a document filed by the department under Ch. 181 is effective on the date it is received by the department for filing, unless a delayed (future) effective date is declared in the document. To name a delayed effective date, enter the future effective date on the appropriate space on the form. The delayed effective date may not be more than 90 days after the date the document is received by the department.

8. Enter your contact information; so we may send you an acknowledgement of this filing or reach you for questions.

NONREFUNDABLE FILING FEE: Make **\$35.00** remittance payable to the [Department of Financial Institutions](#). *Optional expedited service:* The nonrefundable expedited service fee of **\$100.00** is in addition to the filing fee required for this document to be processed, and provides the document will be processed in an expeditious manner.
