Item 1. Enter the name of the entity that previously filed the record that is being withdrawn. If the entity has registered with the Department under a fictitious name, provide the fictitious name as well as the entity’s true name.

Item 2. Enter the title of the record to be withdrawn. Note that this form may not be used to withdraw articles of merger, conversion, interest exchange, or domestication. Entities should instead follow the statutory procedures for abandoning those transactions, including filing a statement of abandonment with the Department prior to the effective date of the transaction.

Item 3. Enter the effective date of the record to be withdrawn. Note that a filed record may be withdrawn only before it becomes effective.

Item 4. Under Wisconsin law, withdrawal of a filed record requires the consent of all persons who signed the record being withdrawn. Mark the first box if all such persons are signing this statement of withdrawal. If the person(s) who signed the filed record are not signing this statement of withdrawal, mark the second box to confirm that the entity has obtained their agreement to withdraw the record.

Item 5. If the first box in item 4 is checked, then this document must be signed by all persons who signed the record being withdrawn. If the second box in item 4 is checked, then the signature requirements for this document depend on the type of entity that is filing it:

If the document is being filed by a business corporation, the document must be executed by an officer of the corporation, subject to two limited exceptions: (1) if directors have not been selected, it may be signed by an incorporator identified in the initial articles of incorporation; and (2) if the corporation is in the hands of a receiver, trustee or other court-appointed fiduciary,

it may be signed by the fiduciary. Corporate directors are not authorized to sign this document in their capacities as directors. (A corporate director who also serves as an officer may sign the document, but that person must sign in their capacity as an officer of the corporation.)

If the document is being filed by a limited partnership or a limited liability limited partnership, the document must be executed by a general partner.

If the document is being filed by any other type of entity, it must be signed by a person authorized by the entity.

Drafter name (if applicable). Drafter name information is required if this document is being filed by a limited liability company that is withdrawing a statement of dissolution before it takes effect. In that circumstance, if the document is executed in Wisconsin, section 182.01(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires that it include the name of the drafter. If the document is not executed in Wisconsin, so indicate in the space provided for the drafter's name.

If this document is not being filed by a limited liability company that is withdrawing a statement of dissolution before it takes effect, you may leave the drafter name blank.

FILING FEE. The statutory filing fee for this document varies depending on the type of entity that is making the withdrawal:

- For **general partnerships** and **limited liability partnerships**, the filing fee is \$40.
- For **all other entity types**, including limited liability companies, business corporations, nonstock corporations, limited partnerships, and limited liability limited partnerships, there is no filing fee.
